# **Approval of Minutes**

#### **New Business**

- Website Update: Braden
  - o The website is still working efficiently, with nominations continuing to come in.
    - Braden will continue to update the committee.
  - o The new owners of Trussardi have inquired about enrolling him in the program.
  - Incomplete online nomination:
    - In the case that an individual begins the nomination process for a stallion but does not pay (stops mid-nomination process), their foals (born after the start of the incomplete nomination) cannot be nominated because the process was never completed.

- This was a recent inquiry that the committee faced. Note: the individual
  was reached out to via email, with no response for over a month. The
  committee will reach out to him next year to get his horses nominated
  before the deadline.
- Committee agrees that if a grace period were to be allowed, it would need to be allowed to all participants.
- Current Nominations:

#### Payouts

- Participants will want to know if there will be lower payouts in the future for both English and Western classes.
- Because of the enrollment over the last three years, the committee expects the payout amounts to increase.
- The payout for 2023 will be from 2020 (covid). In the next 1-2 years, this amount should increase greatly.
- Halter class payouts remain stable.
- If certain monies are not paid due to class being too small to reward the complete amount, the unused funds are rolled over into performance payouts.
- AHT Update (Deb and Melissa)
  - Allison procured artwork for the spotlight program, we will start distributing the week after Scottsdale. The rights to the image have been purchased as well.
  - Jaime Johnson will have a draft of the Spotlight banner going to Scottsdale ready tomorrow (2/11).
  - In the past we modified the banner for whatever advertising we needed. Once we see Jaime's graphics we will likely be able to do this again.
  - Save the Dates going out the first two weeks of March.
  - Payout numbers will be sent out the last two weeks of March.
  - All of March's E-blasts/advertisements will include stallion enrollment.
- Right Holders (Mike Haggan)
  - o Mike will send another communication to right holders after Scottsdale (early March).
    - Introducing new right holders
    - Information and updates on stallion nominations
    - Note: we will add a right holders tab to our website. It is no longer visible.
      - · Mike will email Braden to ask about this.
- Treasurer Report (Mary Scribner)
  - Mare nominations are figured out. The three that were billed out will become right holders.
    - Spotlight still has 4 rights to sell if we count M. Durini and Royal Arabians as confirmed right holders.
    - The website will share that there are limited slots left on the "right holder opportunity page".
- Stallion Nominations (Mike Wilson)

- Mike will be working to find new horses that are not yet in the program as well as renewing those who have participated in the past.
- At Scottsdale, he will focus on horses outside of Region XII.
- The program, with its perks and benefits, is selling itself.
- Keep in mind: There were last minute nominations last year as owners realized their stallions were not going to be included in the Spotlight program.
- The program is to be limited to 150 stallions.

    - Current budget shows 66 bottles of wine. If possible, can we pay a corkage fee and supply our own? Allison will check with Rodney.
      - Is there a possibility of having WEC partner with a winery that they would like to do a tasting with?
    - Rough Budget Plans to negotiate prices further
  - Meals: Plated meals at reserved tables, with a small buffet for extra attendees
  - Paddle Purchase
    - For those without a table
    - \$50 covers 2 drink tickets and buffet access for two
  - Checks: Charles will send an email to Laurie Salmi to get needed contact information for sending out checks.
