New Business

- Half Arabian Nominations
 - 67 In-Utero Nominations
 - 1 and 2 year-olds nominated at \$350
 - 15 horses at \$100
 - 82 HA nominations total
 - 42 paid stallions

- 3 rollovers
- Stallion Nominations
 - Review email from Debbie Atwood to Charles
 - Dominic M and Kid Khan are both coming back to Spotlight (books are being closed)
- New Suggestion: Allow stallion or semen owner to nominate their stallion as a “non-breeding/non-auction” entry
 - This nominates the stallions but removes them from the auction, giving the owner control over which mares breed to the stallion
 - In addition to the nomination fee, they would pay a \$1000 non-nomination fee since the stallion would not be in the live auction. This would then give them both the breeder and stallion owner certificate.
 - This does not open up breeding to this stallion to everyone. The stallion owner has purchased the breeding up front so they can decide who uses that breeding.
 - PROPOSED: \$2,000 flat fee, breeder has one auction certificate.
 - Stallions must be deceased, infertile, or out of the country
- Stallion Presentations
 - No meet and greet presentation this year
 - Presentations will still take place at the auction
- Stallion Nominations
 - With Scottsdale coming up, Mike W will work to get more nominations. The board is encouraged by the amount of nominations that we already have. Part of this is attributed to the seamless use of Spotlight’s website.
